NEEDS:

- Toilet facilities with proper sewage system
- Proper classroom furniture and fittings



THE PROJECT

- Build toilets with two cubicles, complete with septic tank and proper sewage system to ensure waste is disposed in the right manner. Proper waste disposal can help prevent water-borne diseases amongst children and villagers. The toilets will be made of cement, sand, iron and bricks.
- Outfit the classrooms with good quality furniture and flooring so that the younger children can have a more conducive learning environment. Items required are benches, low round tables, carpets and floor mats.






Dysfunctional toilets. Students and teachers no longer use them and opt to answer nature's call outside or go back to their own homes a distance away.


